For cascading curls: A 'beach' waver

Thanks to its three-barrel design, this newfangled curling iron creates natural-looking waves—effortlessly.

To do: Holding the iron horizontally, place a 2" section of hair (starting at the root) between the plates. Clamp down for 5 seconds; release and move down the length of each section. Repeat until all of hair is curled.

For defined coils: A 'hand' diffuser

The diffuser's unique shape evenly distributes heat to enhance curls.

To do: Attach the diffuser to your blow-dryer and dry hair from the ends up.

One to try: DevaCurl DevaFuser, \$50, DevaCurl.com

For soft waves: Steam-heated rollers

Unlike dry-heat rollers that can dry out and damage strands, ones heated by steam use moisture to create soft, voluminous curls.

To do: Wrap 2" sections of hair around a roller; clip up near the ears; remove when cool.
